You have to learn what it means, how to pronounce it, how to use it in a sentence. But there's also the question of how to use the word naturally, as a native speaker. To speak natural English, you must spend time researching collocations. (also known by its English experts) has created several books to help you learn these complex phrases. They have similar books to learn phrasal verbs and idioms in case you want to expand your vocabulary even further. Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary (OALD) of Oxford University is famous for creating one of the largest English dictionaries (with 600,000 entries). More importantly, their experts have also created the Oxford 3000. It is a list of the most useful and commonly used words in English-speaking countries. According to these experts, if you learn these 3,000 words, you can report 80-90% of English conversations, websites, newspapers, etc. These 3,000 words also allow you to understand every word in the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, a special dictionary for students who want to attend an English-speaking university. The latest edition contains 60,000 words and 109,000 examples. OALD contains many specifics that you won't find in other dictionaries – such as synonyms and collocations. You can also download the app version on your smartphone, which allows you to speak the word you want to search for (if you do not know how to write it - which is problem with English words). Best Books for Learning English Grammar It is true that English grammar is not easy. But a lot of books make the subject harder and more confusing than necessary. The three books below are great because they make English grammar as easy as possible - and sometimes even fun. The best thing about these books, of course, is that they help you learn English at home, and quickly. (Note: If your goal is to check English grammar before the IELTS test, it's better to get specialized text.) Using English Grammar (Cambridge) an excellent book to learn English at home raymond murphy's workbook, using English grammar. (Make sure you get the version with the answers.) These are written by linguistics professors who are interested in history, psychology, or science in language - so they do not explain the common problems of English learners. By contrast, practical Use of English is designed specifically for readers who wish to learn English. It was first published in 1980 and has improved several times in the last 40 years. For middle and advanced, it's a great resource. Note, however, that there are no exercises. It offers only explanations and examples. English Grammar: Understanding Basics (Cambridge) If you feel confused about concepts like transitive and periphrastic verbs or demonstrative and interrogative pronouns, then another book to consider is Cambridge University's English Grammar: Understanding the Basics. Unlike the other two books above, this text explains English grammar step by step. This is especially useful if you need to do a lot of writing in English, but also a good read if you want to reach advanced levels quickly. The other two books, then how to fix your mistakes and build longer sentences, but this book will help you understand the big picture in English.
